TOMM[®] provides a SHARED LANGUAGE for staff from different disciplines which enables assessors to make a judgement in a SYSTEMATIC, CONSISTENT and TRANSPARENT manner. TOMM[®] also allows for MULTIPLE AGENCY INTERACTION which means when a client of one service is referred to another their progress is visible to all agencies involved in the persons care.

TOMM[®] provides ASSURANCE FOR FUNDERS that the services they are funding are delivering the desired outcomes (or not if that may be the case). TOMM[®] has the ability to measure outcomes for individuals as well as groups, programmes and services.

TOMM[®] has been developed with the support and input of the Health Research Council of New Zealand, the Ministry of Social Development, youth, academic, cultural and evaluation expert advisors and has been trialled as part of an impact evaluation.

The software is easily adaptable to enable outcomes measurement of various audiences and disciplines.
